

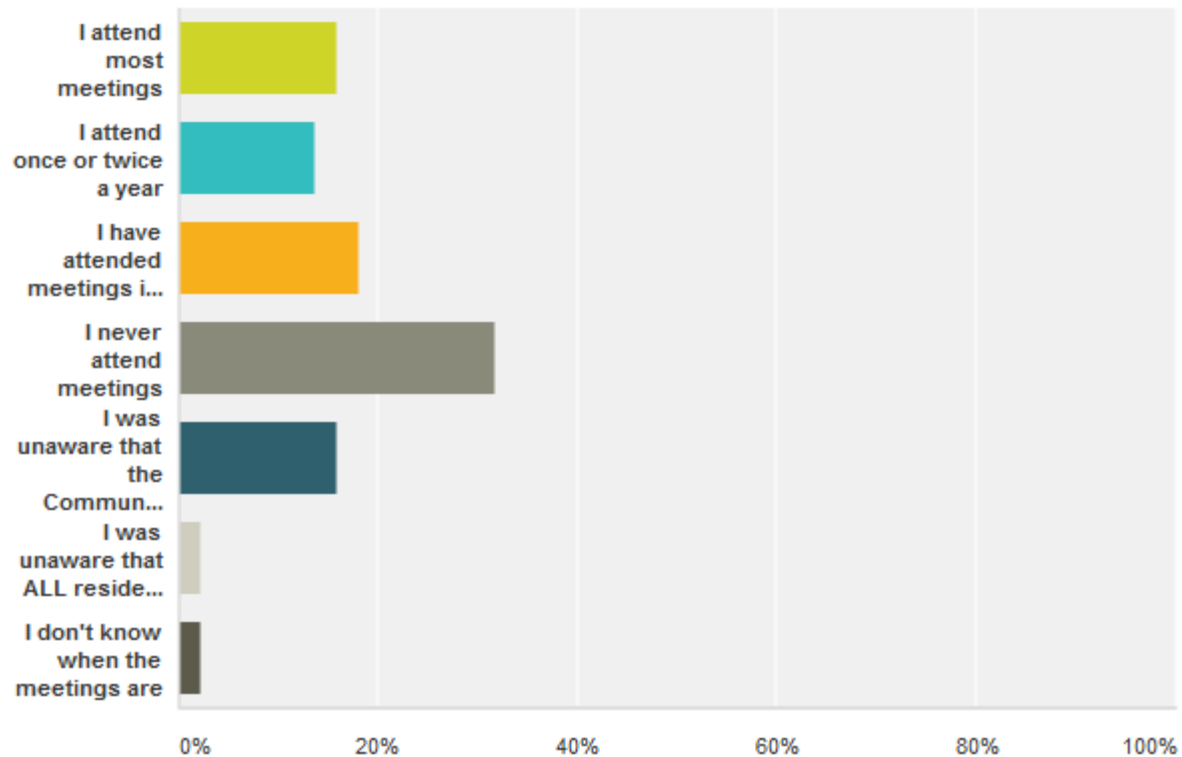
Results from the Survey of Blueridge Residents regarding the BCA

Answered: 44 Skipped: 4

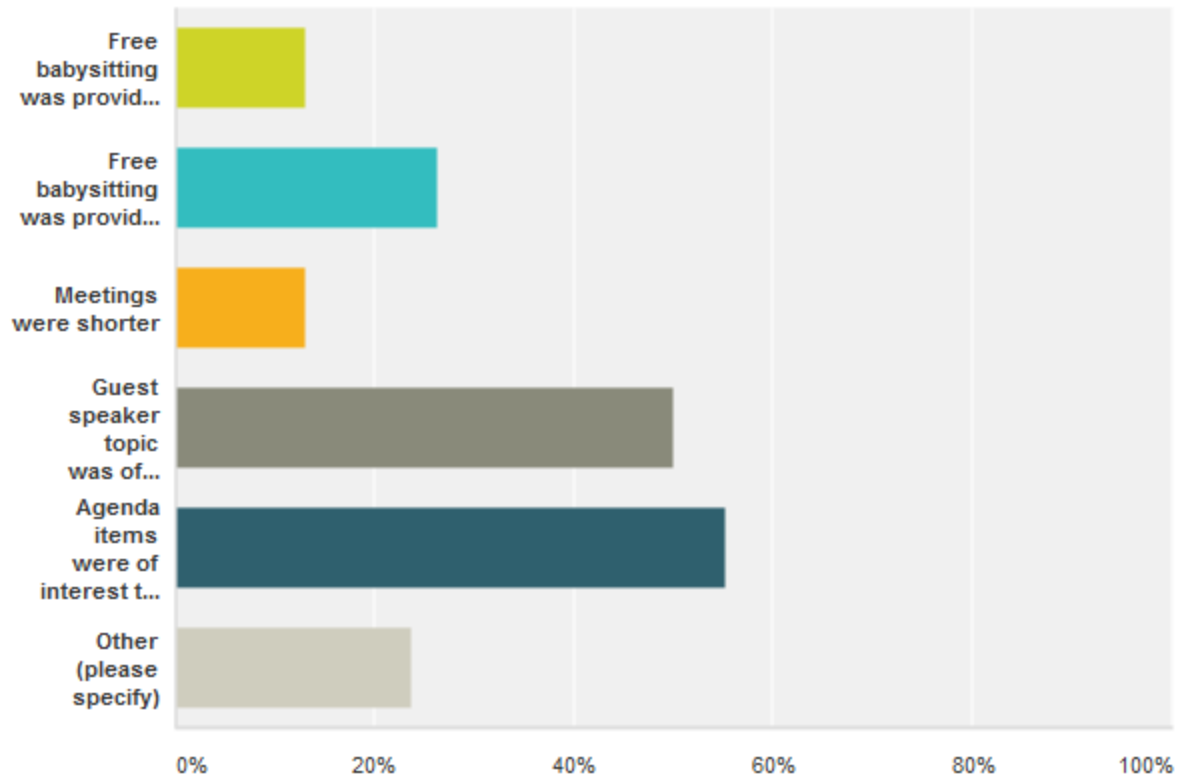


- Recently moved to the area

- time, but I will try to make the next one...I like the upcoming guest speaker



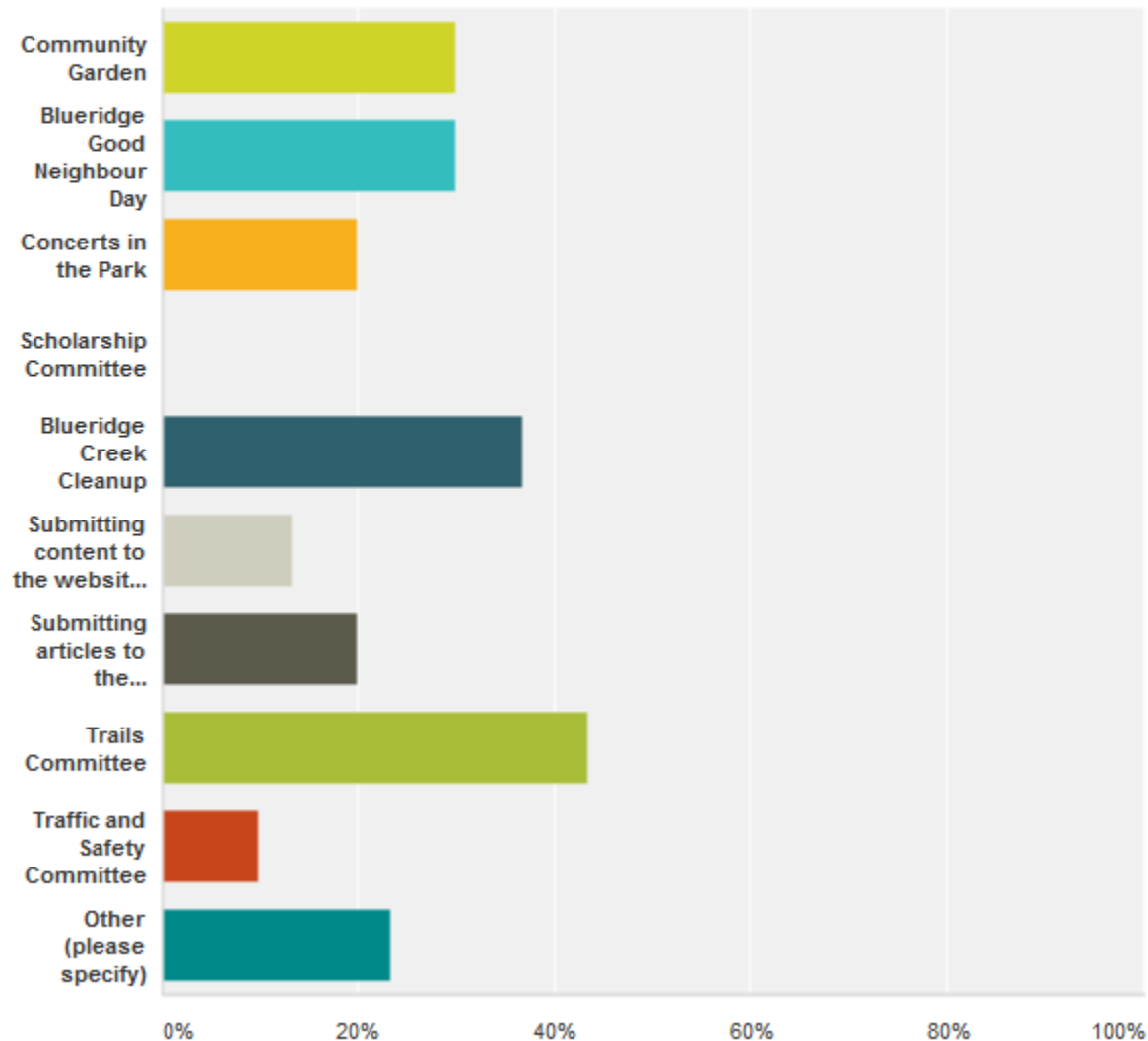
Would you attend Blueridge Community Associations if
