

# BCA Chair's report 2007-2008

At the BCA's Annual General Meeting on May 13, 2008, the Chair Eric G. Andersen pointed out the following achievements for 2007-2008:

1/ meetings were held every second month (November, January, March and May).

2/ we had a couple of guest speakers – North Shore Emergency Management Office, John Fair (biking) and the Metro Vancouver (about the water utility projects)

3/ one newsletter was prepared in 2007-2008 which reached every household in Blueridge/Seymour Heights (thanks strictly to volunteers). One newsletter will be going out in May 2008.

4/ the BCA hosted a very successful 10th Blueridge Good Neighbour Day (anniversary) in June, 2007, at the Blueridge Elementary School. We are working on the 11th BGND.

5/ the BCA general account has a deficit of \$446.13 in addition we have \$5,187.39 earmarked as seed-money for the next Blueridge Good Neighbour Day and \$3,800.00 from the Farmers' Market.

9/ the BCA has invited its residents to a couple of presentations (Natural Hazards as well as Climate Change).
