

Chair's report for 2009-2010

At the BCA's Annual General Meeting on May 11, 2010, the Chair, Eric G. Andersen, pointed out the following achievements for 2009-2010:

1/ meetings were held every second month (September, November, January, March and May).

2/ we had a number of guest speakers – Legacy North Shore, Metro Vancouver presentation on water projects, 'meet your MLA, Jane Thornthwaite', urban planning (by local resident, Ramon Melhado) and North Shore Steamkeepers

3/ two newsletters (May 2009 and April 2010) were prepared in 2009-2010 which reached every household in Blueridge/Seymour Heights (thanks strictly to volunteers). One newsletter is planned on going out in May 2010.

4/ the BCA hosted a very successful 12th Blueridge Good Neighbour Day in June, 2009, at the Blueridge Elementary School. We are working on the 13th BGND.

5/ the BCA general account has a surplus of \$375 - in addition we have \$6362 earmarked as seed-money for the next Blueridge Good Neighbour Day and \$3400 from the Farmers' Market.

7/ the BCA has notified its members of numerous meetings and events of potential interest to them.

8/ the BCA has representatives on the CMAC water committee, Community Advisory Panel, Canlan Ice-Sports Committee, the North Shore Waterfront Liaison Committee and Seymour Local Plan Monitoring Committee.

9/ the BCA was actively involved in the Blueridge Creek clean-up

10/ the BCA hosted an All-Candidates meeting for the School Trustee by-election in September, 2009
