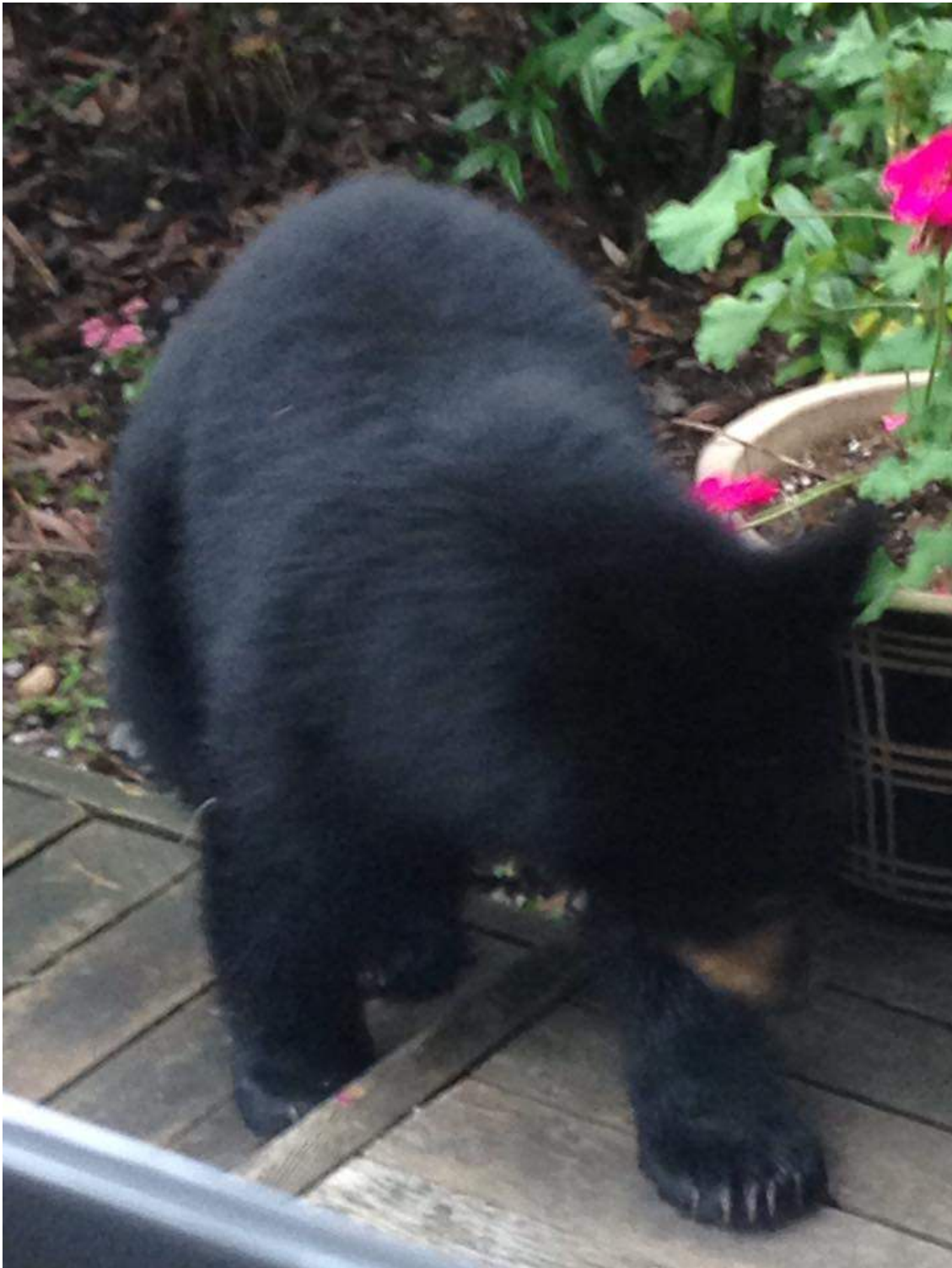


School Board, Crime, Bears, Twin Bridges, Berkley Freeway,
