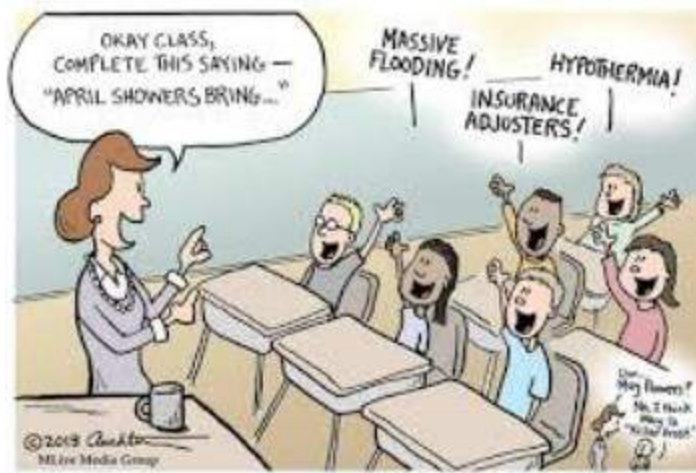

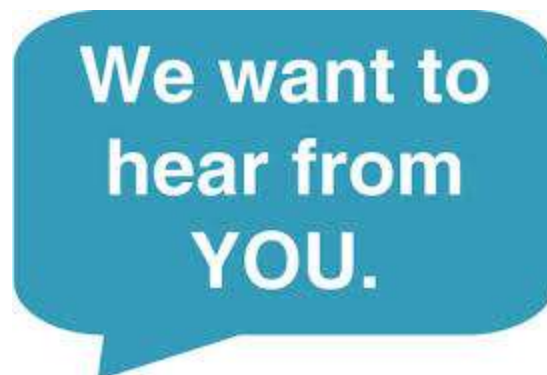


A café near Blueridge? Your voice is needed!

As you may have heard the Seymour Estates (904 – 944 Lytton Street) on the south side of Mount Seymour Parkway is about to be redeveloped. The developer is proposing to triple the density from 114 units to 333 units (including 599 parking stalls).

It is not known what kind of amenities the current residents are getting out of it (other than a lot more density and cars on the roads). Perhaps it is time to ask for a café/coffee shop to be included as part of this redevelopment?

Since this project is likely to go to public hearing soon, please email us your views if you would like to have a café/coffee shop included as part of the redevelopment. This would allow us to have a place to go and enjoy a coffee and meet neighbours. It would also be a great place for the new residents to meet and have a chance to get to know each other. This is community building! Currently, we have to drive to Parkgate or Maplewood to find the nearest coffee shops.
