DNV Parks: Spring 2020 Natural Parklands Events

Saturday March 7 : Harbourview Park, Lower Lynn Creek

10 AM—1 PM : Meet at the park entrance on Harbour Avenue.

After great progress in the fight against invasive plants we are re-establishing native species along Harbourview Park's eastside fence. This creates new opportunities for planting and pulling invasives. Come out and plant bigger trees like Pines, and Arbutus in participation with Bodwell High School and Port Vancouver.



Saturday March 21 : Evergreen Place, Delbrook Neighbourhood

9 AM—12 PM : Meet at western trail head at Mahon Avenue

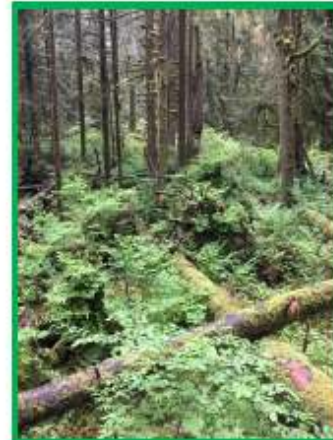
Started by a local family, this trail is being taken back to nature by volunteer efforts. We will be removing invasive species, planting native species, and taking on a general clean up of the pathway.



Saturday March 21 : Myrtle Park, Deep Cove

11 AM—2 PM : Meet at the main parking lot on Banbury Road

This restoration site is alongside a small creek that needs our help. There is no shortage of blackberry and Himalayan balsam to remove, and replacing them with native plants and wood chip is just what it needs.



Saturday March 28 : Kirkstone Park, Lynn Valley

10 AM—1 PM : Meet at the main parking lot on Kirkstone Road

After the success of last year's trail realignment and planting, we will be continuing the work by planting more native species and removing invasives.

Saturday April 4 : Hunter Park, Lynn Valley

10 AM—1 PM : Meet at the trail entrance on Chaucer Avenue

The annual Friends of Hunter Park volunteer event continues its goal of improving the habitat around Hastings Creek for the resident trout and salmon. We will be pulling, planting, and taking on a general park clean up to help out.



Saturday April 4 : Deep Cove Park, Deep Cove

10 AM—1 PM : Meet at the trail head off Rockcliff Road

We will be continuing on a restoration project along the Deep Cove Park trail which will include planting, spreading wood chip, and pulling invasive species.

Saturday April 25 : Princess Park, Lynn Valley

9 AM—12 PM : Meet at the main parking lot on Princess Avenue

The Lynn Valley Community Association invites local residents to come participate in a volunteer restoration event at Princess Park. Volunteers will help with planting along Hastings Creek, protecting sensitive habitat in the process.

Please RSVP with Natural Parkland staff so that we can prepare our tools, gloves, and snacks accordingly. Can't wait to see you out there!!

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Need those Gutters Cleaned?

Project Community Continues to save us \$\$\$\$!

After having successfully completed the cleaning of fireplaces, furnaces, heat pumps and vents and also chimneys for interested parties in Blueridge & Seymour Heights over the winter, we are now offering gutter cleaning again. We did this successfully last year.

We are joining forces with the same company that did it for Blueridge/Seymour Heights residents last year.

The company in question is able to provide the service based on the following promo pricing scenario – all rates quoted are INCLUDING GST:

For split level homes (usually older homes built in the 60's or 70's) between 2000 to 3200 square feet the price would be \$141.75.

For two level homes with basement between 2000 to 3200 square feet the price would be \$173.25.

For homes with two levels and basement that are 3200 square feet or more (usually the newer homes) the price would be \$204.75.

For smaller homes less than 2000 square feet the pricing would be

estimated on site starting at \$89.25.

All work is 100 % Fully Guaranteed, and labour is covered by WCB.

Note: Gutter cleaning is defined as the removal of debris from inside the gutter system. Gutter washing (the washing of the outer metal facing of the gutter) would be an extra charge .

The same company can also help with tree debris removal off your roof, cutting tree branches as well as window-washing – at additional costs, of course.
