Cool Neighbourhoods is now booking thermal imaging visits for homeowners in the District of North Vancouver. Thermal imaging provides an excellent overview of the key areas of heat loss and drafts in your home. The service will highlight gaps in your insulation, drafts around windows and doors, and give you a basic understanding of the energy efficiency of your home.
