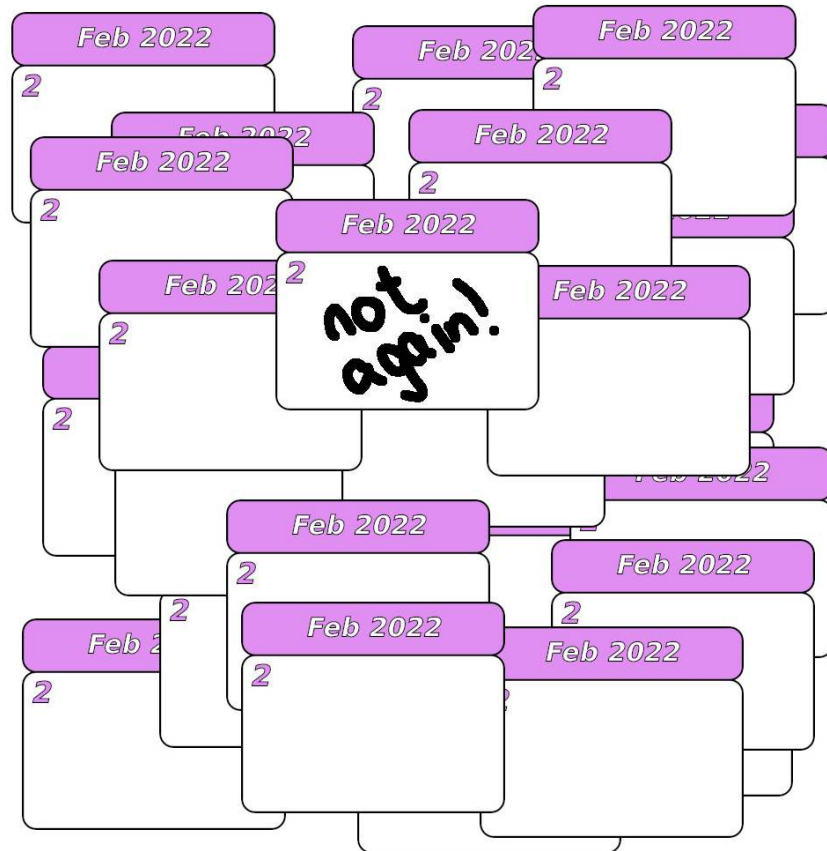


Blueridge Bulletin

Adopt-a-Street Seeing Some Love from the DNV

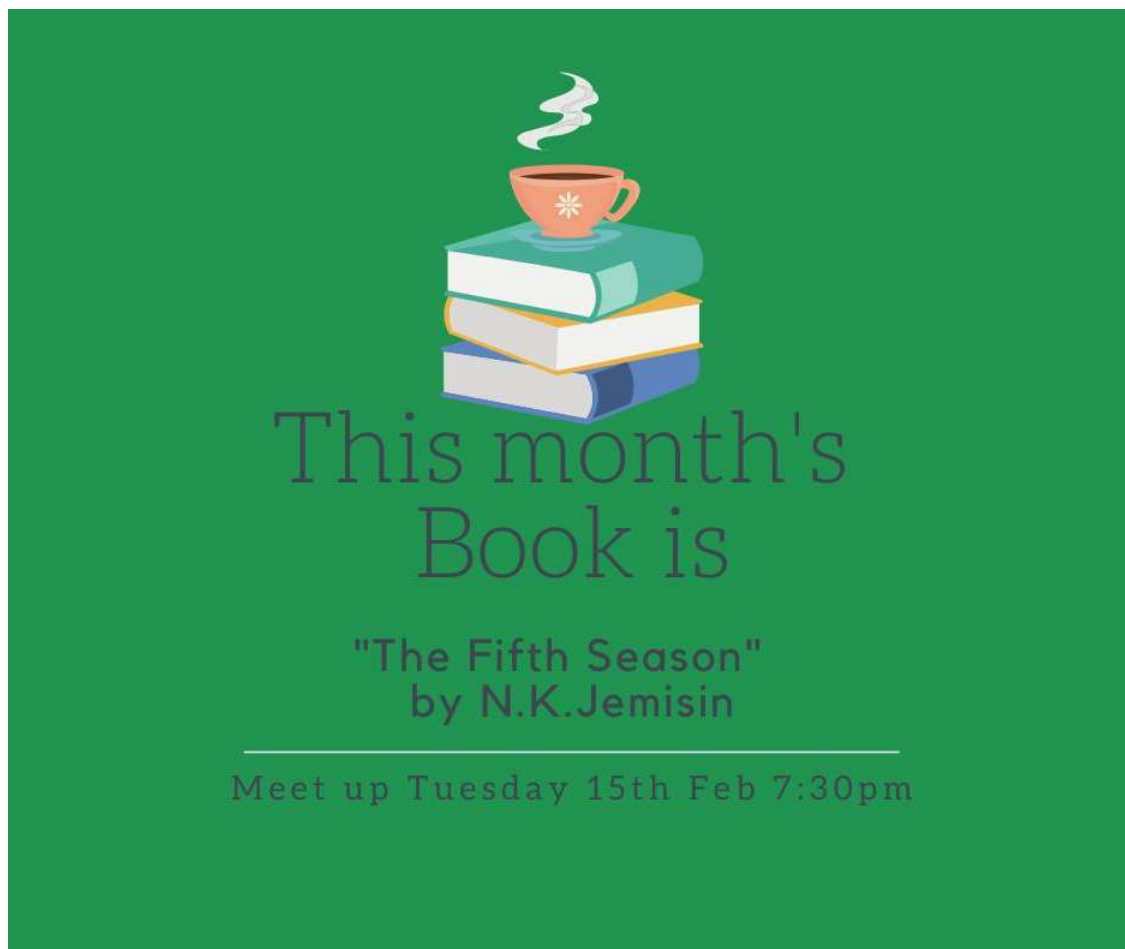

Blueridge Park Playground Equipment Update

Community members asked the BCA to look into the status of the playground equipment at Blueridge Park. We recently got an update from the Section Manager for Parks Planning and Development, Adam Vasilevich:

The Blueridge Park playground will be improved this year and the District of North Vancouver parks needs your help! The play equipment for the 2-5 year age group was replaced six years ago and the equipment for the older children (6-12 year group) will be replaced this year.

A survey will be ready soon for you to share your ideas on possible play features. Below is an approximate timeline for the project:

- Winter – gather public feedback for playground features with a community survey.
- Spring – issue request for proposals, award contract and order replacement play equipment
- Fall – removal of existing play equipment for 6-12 year age group and install new equipment

Project information, updates and the survey will be available on the DNV website soon.
